


# PERE UBU HISTORY



## PERE UBU I SEPTEMBER 1975 to DECEMBER 1975

Pere Ubu was named after the principal character in a series of plays written by Alfred Jarry at the turn of the century. For further information, read the plays. Recorded "30 Seconds Over Tokyo"/"Heart of Darkness" for Hearthan Records in Dec. 1975. Pronunciation: "Pere" as in "pear"; "Ubu" as in "ubu." No photo was taken of this band.

The band's first performance was Dec. 31, 1975. In May 1976 they played Max's in New York for the first time. Also, in May, recorded "Final Solution"/"Cloud 149" on Hearthan. The same version of "Final Solution" also appears on the first Max's Kansas City compilation album. Photo taken May 1976.

## PERE UBU IV JULY 1976 to DECEMBER 1977

Recorded "Street Waves"/"My Dark Ages" on Hearthan in Dec. 1976. Played Max's for the second and third times in Feb. and Apr. 1977. In Sept. 1977 recorded "The Modern Dance"/"Heaven" on Hearthan (limited to 1000 copies). Recorded first LP "The Modern Dance" for Blank Records (formerly Dip/subsidiary of Phonogram) in Oct. 1977. Photo taken Nov. 1977.
